Norway Spruce Conversion - Options and Consequences Heinrich Spiecker 2004 Up to the end of the 19th century, many European forests suffered from devastation and soil deterioration, which caused fears of timber shortage. In order to counteract this possible shortage, many forest areas were reforested with coniferous tree species, especially Norway spruce (*Picea abies* [L.] Karst).
